There are only a few days left to go see the new version of a well known and often staged text by Franz Kafka. But this is the first time that after the “conference” given by the ape-man who tells of his capture, his imprisonment, his metamorphosis, we are able to see two epilogues which were later written by the author of *The Metamorphosis*. Jack Garfein, the American living in Paris has reestablished them and has created a sensitive mise-en-scene in a Rodolfo Natale set. Erik Stouvenaker and Hassam Ghancy give a truthful interpretation of their characters. The first actor through tension and disenchantment and the other, even though his time on scene is quite short, gives a powerful conclusion to the play.
